



God Loves Adam and Eve

Genesis 2:16-17 & 3

Adam and Eve loved God and God loved them.

They lived in a beautiful garden.

Let's pretend to look around in the garden.

Let's look this way (everyone looks right) **and this way** (everyone looks left).

**God gave Adam and Eve so many yummy trees to eat from. But God told Adam,
"Do NOT eat from THIS tree."** (Point to tree)



One day a sneaky snake tricked Adam and Eve.

They ate fruit from God's special tree!

Let's all say, "Oh no!" (Everyone says "Oh no!")

Adam and Eve ran to hide because they were sad.



They were sad because they had disobeyed. But God never stopped loving them.

God promised them someone would come to make things right again.

That someone was Jesus!

Let me hear you say “Jesus!” (Everyone says “Jesus!”)



Jesus Died to Take Away Sins

Matthew 26:53; John 15:13, 17:24; Hebrews 9:22; 1 Peter 3:18

Jesus died on the cross to take away the wrong things we have ALL done.

God sent Jesus to do this because God loves us so much!

The Bible tells us that God loves you (point to kids) **and God loves me** (point to self)!

Let's say this together:

The Bible (make book with hands)

Tells Me (cup hands around mouth)

God Loves Me! (hug self)
