QUESTION SHEET

SAY:

- **Raise your hand if you made a girl with your Playdough.** Let's say there's a shy girl on your team who came to Camp Wannastay for the first time this year. No one else has even tried to talk to her. How could you set the example for the rest of your team who has been ignoring her? (Go talk to her, be her friend!)
- **Raise your hand if you made a fire with your Playdough.** One of the elective hours at Camp Wannastay teaches you how to build a fire. Let's say you already know how because you go camping all the time, but a kid who has been mean to you all summer can't figure it out. How could you be a leader in this situation? (By showing him the right way to do it even though he's been mean to you!) **If you help him anyways, you are being a leader like Jesus, because a lot of people were mean to Him, too.**
- **Raise your hand if you made a cookie with your Playdough.** There's a rule at Camp Wannastay that says you can only have one cookie with each meal. Some of the kids in your cabin have been sneaking extras and have been getting away with it. They told you that you could get away with it too. How could you be a leader in this situation? (Keep following the rule that says you can only get one.) **Right! Leaders do the right thing, even if they could get away with the wrong thing.**
- **Raise your hand if you made a moon with your Playdough.** Let's say your counselor said not to leave the cabin in the middle of the night, but your friends are planning on doing it anyway after your counselor goes to sleep. How could you be a leader and set the right example in this situation? (Obey your counselor!)
- **Raise your hand if you made a sun with your Playdough.** If your mom told you to wear sunscreen every day at camp, but your friends don't think that's cool, should you set the right example by obeying your mom or should you disobey her so your friends will think you're cool? (Set the right example by obeying your mom!) **When your friends get sunburnt, are they going to wish they had followed your lead? (Yes!) Then, the next time you set a good example for them, they'll be more likely to follow your lead!**
