

K-1ST GRADE QUESTION SHEET

SAY:

Neither of your teams is able to complete the puzzle because you each only have half of it! I think you guys are going to have to include each other if you want to finish the puzzle!

Have kids work together on the puzzle. Show them the [Puzzle Guide](#) if needed. After they complete it, **SAY:**

- ***There are some hidden pictures in the puzzle. Who can find the kickball? Let's say your team is playing kickball against the purple team. Some of your friends are telling a kid named Miles that he can't have a turn kicking because he's bad at kickball. Should you go along with your friends or be a leader and tell them that Miles deserves a turn like everyone else?*** (Be a leader and tell them that Miles deserves a turn like everyone else!) ***How would you feel if YOU were the one being left out?*** (Allow responses)
- ***Who can find the pillow? Zach and his friends were having a huge pillow fight! He noticed the new kid sitting on his bunk by himself watching everyone else have fun. Zach decided to invite him to join! Was he being a leader who includes others when he did this?*** (Yes!)
- ***Who can find the green bandana? Braegan won the annual Camp Wannastay Hot Dog Eating Contest! She has a choice—she can have her own private ice cream party every night for the rest of camp, or she can invite the whole green team to one, huge ice cream party! Which one should she choose if she wants to be a leader who includes others?*** (One huge ice cream party with the whole green team!)
- ***Who can find the mess hall tray? Every night at dinner, you and your three best friends sit together in the mess hall. A kid you don't know comes up and sits with you guys. How could you set a good example—by talking to him, or by telling him that he can find somewhere else to sit?*** (By talking to him!)
- ***Who can find the paddle? Let's say that in the camp canoe race, Holden told the rest of his team that he didn't need anyone else to help him paddle because he could beat the green team all by himself. Was he being a leader who includes others?*** (No!)
