











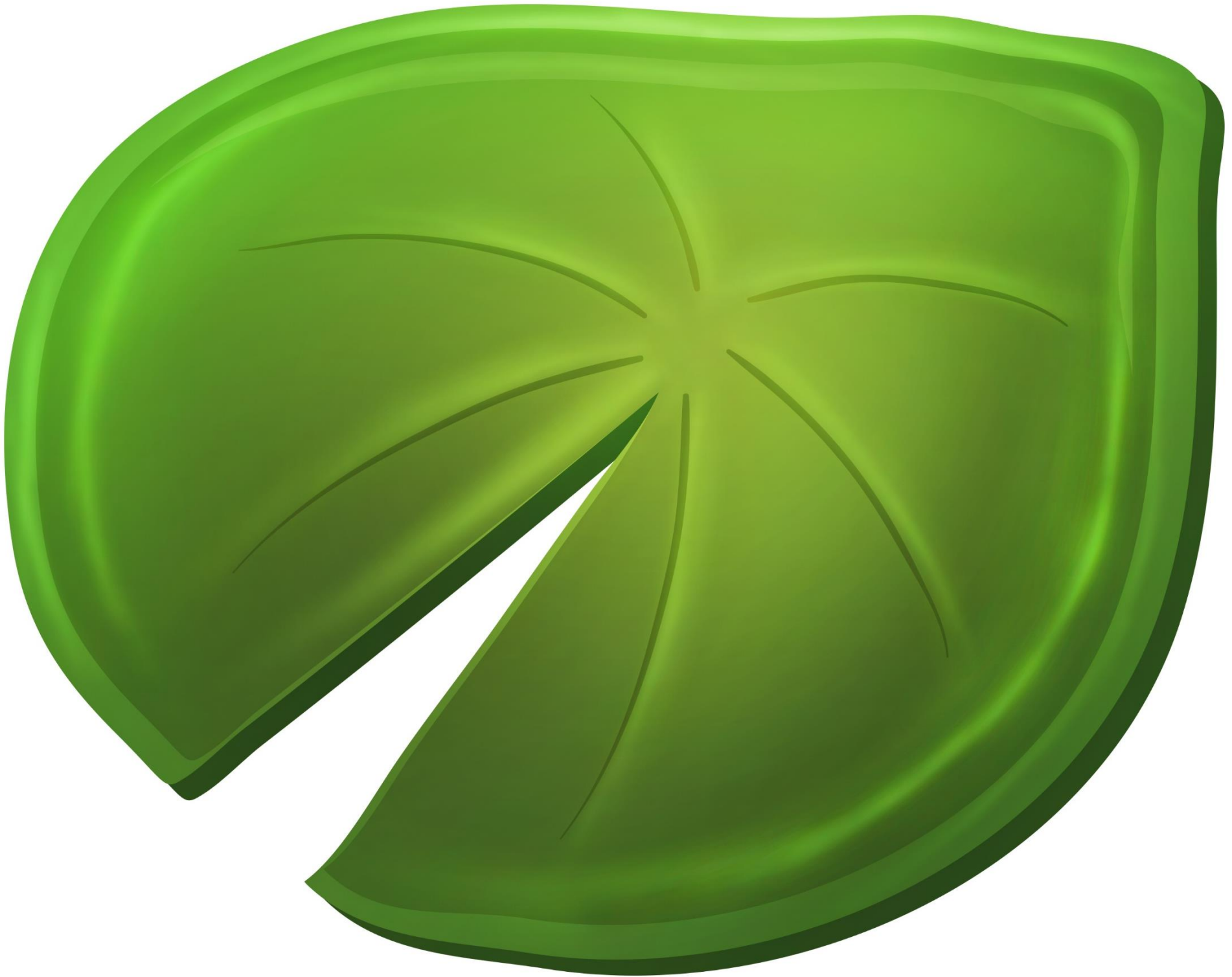
Leaders At Home

-  **Your mom is getting snacks ready for you and your sister. Your sister is really hungry. Should you get the first snack or let your sister get her snack first?** (Allow responses.) **Remember that you can be a leader** (thumbs to chest) **who Lets Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger).
-  **Your brother wants to pick what game to play for family game night. You really want to pick the game, too. If you want to be a leader, should you pick the game or let your brother pick first?** (Allow responses.) **Remember that Leaders** (thumbs to chest) **Let Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger)!
-  **You and your friend are playing in your backyard. You both want to play with the same shovel. Are you being a leader if you let your friend play with it first?** (Yes) **Sometimes it is hard letting others go first. But God knows that we can be Leaders** (thumbs to chest) **who Let Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger)!
-  **Your mom made a special cake for your dad's birthday. It looks so yummy and you want a piece so badly. Should you take the first piece or let your dad have the first piece?** (Allow responses.) **Even when it is hard, God wants us to be Leaders** (thumbs to chest) **who Let Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger)!
-  **The ice cream truck just stopped in front of your house. Your sister is first in line but you really want an ice cream. Should you let your sister go first or should you jump in front of her in line?** (Allow responses.) **You can set a good example to others by being a leader who Lets Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger)!



Leaders Everywhere

-  **Can you let others go first when you are in line for the slide?** (Yes!) **You don't have to push to be first. You can be a Leader** (thumbs to chest) **that Lets Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger)!
-  **If your small group leader has candy to give to your group, should you say, "Me! Me! Me first!" or should you let others go first?** (Let others go first) **You can set a good example for others by letting them go first.**
-  **If your teacher asks a question and you know the answer, should you raise your hand and wait or should you yell out the answer?** (Raise your hand and wait) **Leaders don't have to be the first to do everything! You can be a leader by Letting Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger)!
-  **Can you let others go first when you are in line for the jumpy house?** (Yes) **You don't have to push to be first, but you can wait your turn. Remember that Leaders** (thumbs to chest) **Let Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger)!
-  **Do leaders try to be the first to do everything or do they Let Others** (point to others) **Go First** (show one finger)? (Let others go first) **That's right! If you can be a leader today, let me see you give your friend a high-five!** (Kids will give friends a high-five.)
