(Allow responses.)

Sharing is hard work, but you can be a Leader (thumbs to chest) **that Works Hard** (pound fists) **to set an example for your brother or sister by sharing.**

(Everyone puts one **Yellow Dot Sticker** on **Bug Jar Sheet.**)

Your dad tells you to carry your shoes to your room.

Carrying something all the way to your room can be hard work, but can you be a leader and do it? (Yes)

Clap your hands if you like to eat candy.
(Allow responses.)

You want your mom to buy you candy at the store but she says "no." Should you yell "you're so mean" or should you say "okay?" (Allow responses.)

It is hard work, but you can set an example for others by saying KIND words instead of mean words.

Let's all put one firefly in our jars.
(Everyone puts one **Yellow Dot Sticker** on **Bug Jar Sheet.**)

Wave your hands if you like to play outside. (Allow responses.)

If you are playing in the yard and your dad tells you to come inside, should you hide or should you come inside? (Allow responses.)

You have to work hard (pound fists), **but you can set an example for others by doing what is right.**

Let's all put one firefly in our jars.
(Everyone puts one **Yellow Dot Sticker** on **Bug Jar Sheet.**)

If you like to clean up your toys, pat the ground. (Allow responses.)

If there are a lot of toys to clean up, that can be hard work.

You have to work hard (pound fists), **but you can set an example for others by doing what is right.**

Everyone work hard by keeping your eyes closed tight as you say what we Need to Know after me:

Leaders (thumbs to chest)

Work Hard (pound fists)!

Great job working hard! You can open your eyes. (Kids will open eyes.)

Everyone stand up. (Kids will stand.)

Everyone work hard by hopping in your spot as you say what we Need to Know after me:

Leaders (thumbs to chest)

Work Hard (pound fists)!

Great job working hard! You can sit back down. (Kids will sit.)

Everyone hold your tongue. (Kids will hold tongues.)

Everyone work hard by saying what we Need to Know after me while you hold your tongue:

Leaders (thumbs to chest)

Work Hard (pound fists)!

Great job working hard! As you sit back down, work hard to clean your fingers.
(Give squirt of **hand sanitizer** to each child.)

Everyone stand up. (Kids will stand.)

Everyone work hard by tip-toeing in your spot as you say what we Need to Know after me:

Leaders (thumbs to chest)

Work Hard (pound fists)!

Great job working hard! You can sit back down. (Kids will sit.)

Everyone pat your knees. (Kids will pat knees.)

Everyone work hard by keeping the beat on your knees as you say what we Need to Know after me:

Leaders (thumbs to chest)

Work Hard (pound fists)!

Great job working hard! You can rest your hands now. (Kids will stop patting knees.)
